Course Description

Functional language intervention uses a conversational mode. This goes well with a language sample analysis (LSA) form of assessment. SUGAR (Sampling Utterances and Grammatical Analysis Revised) is a quick, valid, and cost-free LSA mode using a conversational sample. Intervention targets identification and methods will also be discussed.

Course Objectives

At the conclusion of the day, the participant will be able to:

- Provide a rationale for a functional approach for language analysis and intervention
- Describe a SUGAR language analysis
- Quickly calculate the SUGAR metrics
- Identify intervention targets from a language sample with SUGAR
- Describe the use of conversational intervention

****Participants should bring a charged laptop with Microsoft Word installed to actively participate in the SUGAR practice during the afternoon session. The language samples will be provided to the participants via email and should be downloaded to the laptop in advance of the conference.***

Speaker Biography

Robert (“Dr. Bob”) Owens, SUNY Distinguished Teaching Professor, teaches counseling, language development, and language disorders at the College of Saint Rose in Albany. He has authored three texts, *Language Development*, *Language Disorders*, and *Early Language Intervention* and numerous chapters and papers, and co-authored *Introduction to Communication Disorders*. Over his 36 years in the field, Dr. Owens has presented 230 professional workshops and papers around the globe.
