Course Description

This day-long workshop will examine evidence-based practice for working with the transgender and gender expansive individuals. As it will include a strong foundation in “cultural humility” when working with this population it will be relevant to Speech-Language Pathologists in all areas., though this workshop will include a special focus on pediatric work and implications for the school-based SLP. It will cover the primary target areas for voice and communication training, with examples of clinical techniques and a review of the evidence.

Course Objectives

At the conclusion of the day, the participant will be able to:

- 1) Understand and use appropriate terminology with the transgender and gender expansive community
- 2) Identify the several forms of discrimination transgender/gender expansive individuals experience
- 3) Name the primary target areas for gender affirmative voice and communication training
- 4) Understand the current status and limitations of the evidence for the target areas

Speaker Biographical Sketch

Wendy Vastine (they/them), CCC-SLP has been working with the voice – both speaking and singing - in the trans and/or non-binary community for over a decade. They have presented at numerous conferences, lectured in multiple universities, and they have taught and performed nationally and internationally. Wendy holds an MA in Speech-Language Pathology from University of Pittsburgh, and a vocology certification from the National Center for Voice Science, and a BFA in theatre from New York University: Tisch School of the Arts. One of their projects most dear to their heart is that of a peer-based training, which involves training other members of the trans and non-binary community to teach within the community. They are currently living and practicing in the San Francisco Bay Area.
